


*Crochet Curiosities*

❖Notes❖

This pattern is worked in the amigurumi style: working in a continuous spiral with a stitch marker to denote the end of a round.

I use UK terminology here so for everyone else, substitute dc for sc.

The final size of the piece will depend on the yarn size, hook size and crocheting tightness. I used chunky yarn with a 4.5mm hook and the final size of my original was around 15cm.

1. 6dc into magic circle (6)
2. increase around (12)
3. (increase, 1dc) x6 (18)
4. (increase, 2dc) x6 (24)
5. (increase, 3dc) x6 (30)
6. (increase, 4dc) x6 (36)
7. (increase, 5dc) x6 (42)
8. (increase, 6dc) x6 (48)
9. (increase, 7dc) x6 (54)
10. dc around into back loop only
- 11-13. dc around
14. (increase, 8dc) x6 (60)
- 15-17. dc around
18. (increase, 9dc) x6 (66)
- 19-21. dc around
22. (increase, 10dc) x6 (72)
- 23-25. dc around
26. (increase, 11dc) x6 (78)
- 27-29. dc around
30. (increase, 12dc) x6 (84)
- 31-33. dc around
34. (increase, 13dc) x6 (90)

35. ch3, tr around working in back loop only, ss to 1st stitch of round
36. ch3, (tr into back post and front post alternately) repeat around, ss into 1st stitch
37. ch3, (tr into back post and front post alternately) repeat around, ss into 1st stitch
38. ch3, (tr into back post and front post alternately) repeat around, ss into 1st stitch
39. ch3, (tr into back post and front post alternately) repeat around, ss into 1st stitch



40. ch3, (decrease, 7tr) x 10, ss into 1st stitch (80)
41. ch3, (decrease, 6tr) x 10, ss into 1st stitch (70)
42. ch3, (decrease, 5tr) x 10, ss into 1st stitch (60)
43. ch3, (decrease, 4tr) x 10, ss into 1st stitch (50)
44. ch1, (increase, 4dc) x 10, ss into 1st stitch (60)

45. ch1, dc around in front loop only, ss into 1st stitch
  46. ch4, (skip 2 stitches, [dtr, ch2, dtr] in same stitch) x 20, ss into top of foundation chain
  47. ch4, (dtr, ch3, dtr) in space between each two posts x 20
  48. ch1, (3dc in 3ch space, 1dc in space between posts) x 20, ss in 1st stitch
  49. dc around
- Tie off. Sew bottom of collar to body.
